(Senate Bill 269)

AN ACT concerning

Education - Financial Tuition Assistance Bay Child Care Providers

FOR the purpose of establishing a program of tuition assistance to train day <a href="mailto:child">child</a> care providers; authorizing the State Scholarship Administration to adopt certain regulations to implement the program and to award tuition assistance to certain students; prescribing certain qualifications, obligations, and repayment procedures for award recipients; requiring-a-certain-amount-of-tuition-assistance-to-be providing that the tuition assistance program be funded as provided for in the Administration's annual budget; defining certain terms; and generally relating to financial assistance for day <a href="mailto:child">child</a> care providers.
