- (H) (I) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" MEANS THE OBLIGATION OF A RECIPIENT TO PROVIDE DAY CHILD CARE SERVICES AS A SENIOR STAFF MEMBER OR DIRECTOR AT A GROUP-DAY CHILD CARE CENTER, OR AS A FAMILY DAY CARE PROVIDER, IN THE STATE.
- (\pm) (J) "TUITION ASSISTANCE" MEANS ANY FUNDS PROVIDED FOR THE COST OF BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL CHARGES, FEES, ROOM, BOARD, OR OTHER RELATED EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES.

- (A) THERE IS A PROGRAM OF TUITION ASSISTANCE TO TRAIN ĐAY CHILD CARE PROVIDERS.
- (B) THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT INCLUDE:
- (1) PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATIONS AND RENEWALS OF TUITION ASSISTANCE; AND
- (2) REQUIREMENTS THAT A TUITION ASSISTANCE RECIPIENT PROVIDE TO THE STATE ADEQUATE FINANCIAL SECURITY TO ASSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE SERVICE OBLIGATION.
- (C) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS DETERMINE ACADEMIC CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF TUITION ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS FROM ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS.
- (2) THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT ANY OTHER REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS SUBTITLE. 18-1803.
