Section 3

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Agriculture

10-1301.

(A) (1) The General Assembly defines aquaculture as an agricultural activity.

(2) Aquaculture includes the commercial rearing of finfish, shellfish, and aquatic plants for sale, trade, barter, or shipment.
