SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

18-335.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

- (B) BEFORE OBTAINING A BLOOD SAMPLE FROM AN INDIVIDUAL FOR THE PURPOSE OF TESTING THE BLOOD FOR THE PRESENCE OF HIV INFECTION, A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER SHALL:
