INTERPRET A TEST FOR THE PRESENCE OF HIV MAY NOT BE HELD LIABLE IN ANY CAUSE OF ACTION RELATED TO:

- (1) A BREACH OF PATIENT CONFIDENTIALITY; OR
- (2) A PHYSICIAN'S DECISION TO DISCLOSE OR NOT TO DISCLOSE INFORMATION RELATED TO A POSITIVE TEST RESULT TO A LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER AND/OR AN INDIVIDUAL'S SEXUAL AND NEEDLE-SHARING PARTNERS.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- DETENTION OR CORRECTIONAL CONFINEMENT OPERATED BY OR FOR THE STATE OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT.
 - (3) "CORRECTIONAL EMPLOYEE" MEANS:
- INSTITUTION; OR (I) A PERSON WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A CORRECTIONAL
- (II) A PERSON WHO PERFORMS DUTIES IN A CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION BY VIRTUE OF FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYMENT.
- (4) "EXPOSURE" MEANS, AS BETWEEN A CORRECTIONAL EMPLOYEE AND AN INMATE:
- (I) PERCUTANEOUS CONTACT WITH BLOOD, SEMEN, OR BLOOD CONTAMINATED FLUIDS;
- (II) MUCOCUTANEOUS CONTACT WITH BLOOD, SEMEN, OR BLOOD CONTAMINATED FLUIDS;
- (III) OPEN WOUND (DERMATITIS, INCLUDING DERMATITIS, EXUDATIVE LESIONS, OR CHAPPED SKIN) SKIN, CONTACT WITH BLOOD, SEMEN, OR BLOOD CONTAMINATED FLUIDS; AND
- BLOOD, SEMEN, OR BLOOD CONTAMINATED FLUIDS FOR A PROLONGED PERIOD.
- (5) "HEALTH CARE PROVIDER" MEANS ANY PERSON, INCLUDING A PHYSICIAN OR HOSPITAL, WHO IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED IN THIS STATE TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND IS UNDER CONTRACT WITH OR OPERATED BY THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
- (B) AN INMATE SHALL FURNISH TO THE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION A BLOOD SAMPLE TO BE TESTED FOR THE PRESENCE OF HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) WHEN:
