LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (4) (I) "HOTEL" MEANS A BUILDING OR GROUP OF BUILDINGS UNDER THE SAME MANAGEMENT IN WHICH THERE ARE MORE THAN 16 SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS FOR HIRE, PRIMARILY USED BY TRANSIENTS WHO ARE LODGED WITH OR WITHOUT MEALS.
- (II) "HOTEL" INCLUDES AN INN, MOTEL, CLUB, OR APARTMENT HOTEL.
- (5) (I) "LODGING OR ROOMING HOUSE" MEANS A BUILDING IN WHICH SEPARATE SLEEPING ROOMS ARE RENTED PROVIDING SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS FOR A TOTAL OF 16 OR FEWER PERSONS ON EITHER A TRANSIENT OR PERMANENT BASIS, WITH OR WITHOUT MEALS BUT WITHOUT SEPARATE COOKING FACILITIES FOR INDIVIDUAL OCCUPANTS.
- (II) "LODGING OR ROOMING HOUSE" INCLUDES AN INN, CLUB, OR BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENT.
- (6) (I) "MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL DWELLING" MEANS A BUILDING OR PORTION OF A BUILDING THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN 2 DWELLING UNITS AND IS NOT CLASSIFIED AS A 1 OR 2 FAMILY DWELLING.
- (II) "MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL DWELLING" DOES NOT INCLUDE A TOWNHOUSE.

[7] [1] "PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM" MEANS A SYSTEM THAT:

- HUMAN CONSUMPTION; AND 1. PROVIDES TO THE PUBLIC PIPED WATER FOR
- CONNECTIONS; OR 2. A. HAS AT LEAST 15 SERVICE
- INDIVIDUALS.

 B. REGULARLY SERVES AT LEAST 25

(11) "PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM" INCLUDES:

- DISTRIBUTION FACILITY THAT IS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE OPERATOR OF THE SYSTEM AND IS USED PRIMARILY IN CONNECTION WITH THE SYSTEM; AND
- 2. ANY COLLECTION OR PRETREATMENT STORAGE FACILITY THAT IS NOT UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE OPERATOR OF THE SYSTEM AND IS USED PRIMARILY IN CONNECTION WITH THE SYSTEM.
 - (8) "SPRINKLER SYSTEM" MEANS A DEVICE THAT:
- (I) OPENS AUTOMATICALLY BY OPERATION OF A HEAT RESPONSIVE RELEASING MECHANISM;
- (II) DISCHARGES WATER IN A SPECIFIC PATTERN OVER A DESIGNATED AREA TO EXTINGUISH OR CONTROL FIRE;
