FOR the purpose of requiring the Prince George's County Council to-consider-certain-factors-before-the-County-Council-issues a-grading,-drainage,-or-erosion-control-permit or a certain department of the County to place conditions on certain grading permits for certain land in the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District under certain conditions.
