

[(f)] (G) "Liquid waste" means:

(1) STORM WATER RUNOFF; AND

(2) [any] ANY water-carried wastes or wastes which are liquid in nature created in and carried away, or to be carried away, from residences, institutions, industrial establishments, commercial establishments, or any other public or private building, structure, or facility.

[(g)] (H) "Municipality" means any county, municipal corporation, sanitary district, State or local unit, or other public body or unit created or established by or pursuant to State or local law, ordinance, or resolution [which has jurisdiction over water supply or disposal of liquid wastes or solid wastes or is established for the purposes of providing water supply services or collecting, transporting, purifying, or disposing of liquid wastes or solid wastes].

(I) "NOTES" MEANS BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES, REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES, AND GRANT ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE SERVICE, WHETHER GENERAL OR LIMITED OBLIGATIONS OF THE SERVICE.

[(h)] (J) "Person" means any natural person, individual, firm, partnership, association, cooperative, corporation, or other entity [that, under State or federal law, has responsibility for water supply or wastewater or solid waste disposal. This word does not include any natural person, individual, firm, partnership, association, cooperative, corporation, or other entity receiving or entitled to receive water supply, wastewater collection, or solid waste collection services from a municipality].

[(i)] (K) (1) "Project" means a solid waste disposal project, a wastewater purification project, or a water supply project as the case may be.

(2) "PROJECT" INCLUDES ANY SERVICE, FACILITY, OR PROPERTY USED OR USEFUL OR HAVING PRESENT CAPACITY FOR FUTURE USE IN CONNECTION WITH:

(I) THE TRANSPORTING, TRANSFERRING, COMPACTING, BURYING, INCINERATING, REDUCTION, COMPOSTING, COLLECTION, STORAGE, TREATMENT, UTILIZATION, PROCESSING, OR FINAL DISPOSAL OF LIQUID WASTES, SOLID WASTES OR WATER, AS THE CASE MAY BE;

(II) THE CONVERSION OF LIQUID WASTES, SOLID WASTES OR WATER, AS THE CASE MAY BE, TO FUEL, STEAM, ELECTRICITY, ENERGY, OR OTHER RESOURCES OR THE GENERATION OF STEAM, ELECTRICITY, OR OTHER FORMS OF ENERGY FROM FUEL WHICH IS DERIVED FROM, OR IS OTHERWISE RELATED TO, LIQUID WASTES, SOLID WASTES OR WATER, AS THE CASE MAY BE;
