## LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (A) BY JANUARY 1, 1990, EACH COUNTY SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT A-PHAN AN ASSESSMENT OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FROM RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY TO THE SECRETARY.
- (B) A--PLAN THE ASSESSMENT PREPARED AND SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE-FOR:
  - +1+--AT-LEAST-1-COLLECTION-DAY-IN-1990:-AND
  - +2)--FOR-EACH-CALENDAR-YEAR-THEREAFTER: INCLUDE:
- (1) THE ESTIMATED COST OF PROVIDING ONE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY EVERY YEAR;
- (2) THE FEASIBILITY AND ESTIMATED COST OF ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY EVERY YEAR FOR THE COUNTY'S GEOGRAPHIC REGION OF THE STATE; AND
- (3) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT WOULD BE OF USE TO THE STATE IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO MANDATE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAYS IN EACH COUNTY.
