

(A) BY JANUARY 1, 1990, EACH COUNTY SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT A-PLAN AN ASSESSMENT OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FROM RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY TO THE SECRETARY.

(B) A--PLAN THE ASSESSMENT PREPARED AND SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE-FOR:

~~(1) --AT-LEAST-1-COLLECTION-DAY-IN-1990;-AND~~

~~(2) --FOR-EACH-CALENDAR-YEAR-THEREAFTER- INCLUDE:~~

(1) THE ESTIMATED COST OF PROVIDING ONE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY EVERY YEAR;

(2) THE FEASIBILITY AND ESTIMATED COST OF ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY EVERY YEAR FOR THE COUNTY'S GEOGRAPHIC REGION OF THE STATE; AND

(3) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT WOULD BE OF USE TO THE STATE IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO MANDATE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAYS IN EACH COUNTY.

(House Bill 1160)

AN ACT concerning

Duck Blinds - Bird River - Baltimore County
