- (2) Does not represent as true any matter that the person does not reasonably believe to be true.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 828

(House Bill 1535)

AN ACT concerning

State Finance - Appropriated Funds - Designated Payments

FOR the purpose of clarifying a provision that requires a certain affidavit from certain institutions and corporations that receive certain State money; and generally relating to the disbursement of certain appropriations to institutions and corporations.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - State Finance and Procurement Section 7-221 Annotated Code of Maryland (1988 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Finance and Procurement

7-221.

- (a) The Comptroller, the Chief Deputy Comptroller, or a deputy comptroller may not issue a warrant for disbursement of an appropriation to an institution or corporation unless the Comptroller has on file an affidavit that complies with the requirements of this section.
- (b) An affidavit under this section shall state that the affiant personally knows that no money <u>FROM STATE FUNDS</u> has been paid or promised -f-to any legislative agent, lawyer, or lobbyist for any service to obtain the appropriation-j- FOR-USE-OTHER-THAN THE-PURPOSE-FOR-WHICH-THE-MONEY-WAS-APPROPRIATED.
