

2-309. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

(A) NOTICE TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS.

IF AN APPLICANT QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD SHALL SEND THE APPLICANT A NOTICE THAT STATES THAT:

(1) THE APPLICANT HAS QUALIFIED FOR A LICENSE; AND

(2) ON RECEIPT OF A \$25 LICENSE FEE, THE BOARD WILL ISSUE A LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT.

(B) ISSUANCE.

ON PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

2-310. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

WHILE A LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY.

2-311. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSE.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

UNLESS A LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST DECEMBER 31 THAT COMES:

(1) AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LICENSE; AND

(2) IN AN EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR.
