AN ACT concerning

Interagency Committee on Aging Services - Older Marylanders Act

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Interagency Committee on Aging Services; changing the scope of the Committee's responsibilities; providing for an Executive Director of the Committee; identifying certain services to which older persons will have access through a single point of entry; providing for a services system for certain frail or health impaired elderly persons; and generally relating to services for elderly persons.
