(4) (I) ON RECEIPT BY THE COMPTROLLER, LICENSE FEES FROM THE TRANSFER OF OIL SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MARYLAND OIL DISASTER CONTAINMENT, CLEAN-UP AND CONTINGENCY FUND.

(II) WHEN THE BALANCE IN THE FUND FROM THE MONTHLY LICENSE FEES PAID UNDER THIS SUBSECTION INTO THE FUND EQUALS OR EXCEEDS A MAXIMUM LIMIT OF \$750,000, COLLECTION OF SUBSEQUENT MONTHLY LICENSE FEES SHALL BE ABATED UNTIL:

1. THE BALANCE IN THE FUND BECOMES LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO \$500,000; OR

2. THERE IS EVIDENCE THAT THE BALANCE IN THE FUND COULD BE SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCED BY THE RECENT OCCURRENCE OF A MAJOR DISCHARGE OR SERIES OF DISCHARGES.

(5) (I) ON RECEIPT BY THE COMPTROLLER, THE ADDITIONAL LICENSE FEES FROM THE TRANSFER OF GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE MARYLAND UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK FUND.

(II) IN ADDITION, ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1990, A ONE-TIME, \$50 FEE ON EACH UNDERGROUND OIL STORAGE TANK SHALL BE PAID BY AN OWNER TO THE DEPARTMENT AND CREDITED TO THE UST FUND.

(III) WHEN THE BALANCE IN THE UST FUND FROM THE MONTHLY LICENSE FEES PAID UNDER THIS SUBSECTION INTO THE UST FUND EQUALS OR EXCEEDS A MAXIMUM LIMIT OF \$12,000,000, COLLECTION OF SUBSEQUENT MONTHLY LICENSE FEES SHALL BE ABATED UNTIL:

1. THE BALANCE IN THE UST FUND BECOMES LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO \$8,000,000; OR

2. THERE IS EVIDENCE THAT THE BALANCE IN THE UST FUND COULD BE SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCED BY THE RECENT OCCURRENCE OF A MAJOR DISCHARGE OR SERIES OF DISCHARGES.
