Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 687.

This bill allows the Department of Natural Resources to establish aquaculture oyster seed areas and to sell the seed oysters derived from those seed areas to specified persons. The Department would also be authorized to adopt regulations to implement these provisions.
