SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-804.1.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "GRANT" MEANS THE HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT FOR ~~COMMUNITY COLLEGES INSTITUTIONS OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION~~ COMMUNITY COLLEGES OFFERING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS LEADING TO LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN HEALTH OCCUPATIONS DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY.

(B) (1) THERE IS A HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM FOR ~~COMMUNITY COLLEGES INSTITUTIONS OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION~~ COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

(2) THE GRANT PROGRAM SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(3) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM.
