(f) If another licensing jurisdiction requests a driving record from the Administration, the Administration may send the record to it without charge.

16-111.

(a) An applicant is entitled to receive the driver's license applied for if the applicant:

(1) Passes the examination provided for in this subtitle;

(2) Surrenders the last learner's permit issued to him, if any; and

(3) Pays the fees provided for by this subtitle.

(b) (1) Each license issued by the Administration shall be identified clearly as to its specific class. A Class E license may be issued in combination with any one of the other classes.

(2) The Administration shall assign an identifying number to each license it issues.

(3) To the extent provided by federal law, the Administration may use a driver's social security number as an identifying number for a driver's license.

(c) Each license issued by the Administration:

(1) Shall be of the size, design, and content that the Administration specifies;

(2) Shall include:

(i) The name and residence address of the licensee;

(ii) The date of birth of the licensee;

(iii) A description of the licensee, which shall include the height, weight, and sex of the licensee;

(iv) The type or class of vehicles that the license authorizes the licensee to drive;

(v) The signature and seal of the issuing agent; and

(vi) A space for the signature of the licensee; and
