(f) If another licensing jurisdiction requests a driving record from the Administration, the Administration may send the record to it without charge.

## 16-111.

- (a) An applicant is entitled to receive the driver's license applied for if the applicant:
- (1) Passes the examination provided for in this subtitle;
- (2) Surrenders the last learner's permit issued to him, if any; and
  - (3) Pays the fees provided for by this subtitle.
- (b) (1) Each license issued by the Administration shall be identified clearly as to its specific class. A Class E license may be issued in combination with any one of the other classes.
- (2) The Administration shall assign an identifying number to each license it issues.
- (3) To the extent provided by federal law, the Administration may use a driver's social security number as an identifying number for a driver's license.
  - (c) Each license issued by the Administration:
- (1) Shall be of the size, design, and content that the Administration specifies;
  - (2) Shall include:
- (i) The name and residence address of the licensee;
  - (ii) The date of birth of the licensee;
- (iii) A description of the licensee, which shall include the height, weight, and sex of the licensee;
- (iv) The type or class of vehicles that the license authorizes the licensee to drive;
- (v) The signature and seal of the issuing
  agent; and
- (vi) A space for the signature of the licensee;
