AN ACT concerning

Caroline County - Sheriff's Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Caroline County Sheriff; and providing that the salary increase does not affect the incumbent sheriff.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 2-309(g) Annotated Code of Maryland (1984 Replacement Volume and 1988 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings
