WILLIAM DONALD SCHAEFER, Governor

THE SECRETARY SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GOVERNOR'S EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING COUNCIL AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE OPERATION AND PERFORMANCE OF THE PARTNERSHIP FOR WORKFORCE OUALITY.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Workforce Quality Advisory Board shall expire as follows:
 - (1) 5 members in 1992;
 - (2) 5 members in 1991; and
 - (3) 5 members in 1990.

Thereafter, the terms of the members shall be staggered as provided in this Act.

SECTION-2:--AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED;-That-the-terms-of-the initial--members--of-the--Workforce-Quality-Advisory-Board-shall expire-as-follows:

(1)--5-members-in-1992;

+2}--5-members-in-1991;-and

+31--5-members-in-1990-

Thereafter,-the-terms--of--the--members--shall--be--staggered--as provided-in-this-Act;

SECTION--3.---AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED,-That-this-Act-shall take-effect-July-1,-1989;

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 1992, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
