AN ACT concerning

Maryland Medical Assistance Program and Community-Based Initiatives

FOR the purpose of establishing a State policy for the Maryland Medical Assistance Program; requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program to provide promote educational opportunities for Program recipients on certain aspects of health care and to work with certain groups to assist in the education of Program recipients; expanding the coverage of the Program to include all infants and pregnant women who fall below a certain poverty level; specifying that the Program may further expand for infants and children under certain circumstances; specifying-a-funding-source-for-the expansion-of-the-Program; specifying that the-Secretary-of Health-and-Mental-Hygiene-may-renew certain contracts
