- (6) REFUSES, WITHHOLDS FROM, DENIES, OR DISCRIMINATES AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WITH REGARD TO THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR WHICH THE LICENSEE IS LICENSED AND QUALIFIED TO RENDER BECAUSE OF-THE-INDIVIDUAL'S-MENTAL-OR PHYSICAL-HANDICAP THE INDIVIDUAL IS HIV POSITIVE.

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 15-313 of this subtitle, the Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its members then serving, may deny a license or a limited license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee or holder of a limited license, impose an administrative monetary penalty not exceeding \$5,000 on any licensee or holder of a limited license, place any licensee or holder of a limited license on probation, or suspend or revoke a license or a limited license if the applicant, licensee, or holder:
- (21) Has had a license to practice podiatry denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section; [or]
- (22) Violates any rules or regulations adopted by the $\mbox{\sc Board; OR}$
- (23) REFUSES, WITHHOLDS FROM, DENIES, OR DISCRIMINATES AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WITH REGARD TO THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR WHICH THE LICENSEE IS LICENSED AND QUALIFIED TO RENDER BECAUSE OF-THE-INDIVIDUAL'S-MENTAL-OR PHYSICAL-HANDICAP THE INDIVIDUAL IS HIV POSITIVE.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 15.5-314 of this subtitle, the Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its members then serving, may deny a certificate to any applicant, reprimand any certificate holder, or suspend or revoke a certificate of any certificate holder if the applicant or certificate holder:

- (9) Violates any rule or regulation adopted by the Board; [or]
- (10) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority of any other state or country or convicted or
