(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "GRANT" MEANS THE HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES OFFERING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS LEADING TO LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN HEALTH OCCUPATIONS DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY.

(B) (1) THERE IS A HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

(2) THE GRANT PROGRAM SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(3) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM.

(C) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE:

(1) HAS AN APPROVED EDUCATION PROGRAM LEADING TO LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN A HEALTH OCCUPATION DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY;

(2) RECEIVES OPERATING FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY OR COUNTIES HAVING JURISDICTION OVER THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF AN AMOUNT OF NOT LESS THAN IT RECEIVED DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.

(D) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION A COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL RECEIVE A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500 FOR EACH STUDENT WHO GRADUATES FROM AN APPROVED EDUCATION PROGRAM LEADING TO LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN A HEALTH OCCUPATION DETERMINED TO BE IN SHORT SUPPLY, THAT IS IN EXCESS OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO GRADUATED FROM THE APPROVED EDUCATION PROGRAM AT THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE DURING ACADEMIC YEAR 1987-88.

(E) IF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE GRANT TO BE ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION IS MORE THAN THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET, THE AMOUNT OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S GRANT FOR THAT PERIOD SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE PRODUCT OF:

(1) THE AMOUNT REQUIRED TO PAY GRANTS UNDER SUBSECTION (D) MULTIPLIED BY:

(2) THE RATIO OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE TOTAL AMOUNT REQUIRED TO PAY GRANTS UNDER THIS SECTION TO ALL ELIGIBLE COMMUNITY COLLEGES.
