- (c) (1) This subsection applies only in the following counties:
 - (i) Carroll County;
 - (ii) Frederick County;
 - (III) HARFORD COUNTY;
 - [(iii)] (IV) Somerset County;
 - [(iv)] (V) Talbot County; and
 - [(v)] (VI) Wicomico County.
- (2) A licensee under the provisions of this article, or any of his employees, may not sell or furnish any alcoholic beverages[, other than beer and light wine,] at any time to a person under 21 years of age, either for his own use or for the use of any other person, or to any person who, at the time of such sale or delivery, is visibly under the influence of any alcoholic beverage.
- (3) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section do not apply to the counties which are listed in paragraph (1) of this subsection and the law in these counties shall remain in the same force and effect as if not amended by this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
