- (f) The Maryland Port Administrator or a designee;
 - (g) A member of the Governor's staff;
- (h) The Mayor of the City of Annapolis or a designee;
- (i) The Superintendent of the U.S. Naval Academy or a designee; and
 - (j) The State Archivist or a designee.
- (3) The members of the Commission shall serve through the culmination of the international commemoration in 1993. However, the Governor may remove a member for any cause adversely affecting the member's ability or willingness to perform his or her duties.
- (4) The Governor shall appoint co-chairmen for the Commission.
 - (5) Commission procedures.
- (a) A majority of the Commission's members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business.
- (b) The Commission may adopt such other procedures necessary to ensure the orderly transaction of business.
 - (6) Commission expenses.
- (a) The members of the Commission may not receive compensation for their services.
- (b) The members may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, in accordance with the standard travel regulations, and as provided in the State budget.
- (7) As provided in the State budget, the Secretary of Economic and Employment Development shall provide staff support necessary for the completion of the Commission's duties.
- C. Duties and Responsibilities of the Commission. The Commission shall have the following responsibilities and duties:
- (1) The Commission shall work in tandem with Columbus 500/Baltimore.
