SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

12-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

"APPRENTICE PLUMBER" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO ASSIST A MASTER PLUMBER OR A HOLDER OF A LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES WHILE:

(1) UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE MASTER PLUMBER OR HOLDER OF THE LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE; AND

(2) IN TRAINING TO BECOME A JOURNEY PLUMBER.
