SUBTITLE 3. LICENSING.

12-301. LICENSE REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PROVIDE PLUMBING SERVICES BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY PROVIDE PLUMBING SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PROVIDE OR TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY ASSIST IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(B) EXCEPTION -- HOMEOWNER OR OCCUPANT OF RESIDENCE.

(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PERSONALLY PROVIDES PLUMBING SERVICES IN THE RESIDENCE OF THE INDIVIDUAL.

(2) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT PROVIDE PLUMBING SERVICES THAT MAKE A FINAL CONNECTION BETWEEN THE RESIDENCE OF THE INDIVIDUAL AND A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OR WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM.
