12-303. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES; AND

(2) PAY TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE OF:

(I) \$20 FOR A MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE;

(II) \$10 FOR A JOURNEY PLUMBER LICENSE; OR

(III) \$15 FOR AN APPRENTICE PLUMBER LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Art. 56A, § 3-303.

In item (2)(iii) of this section, the reference to a \$15 fee is substituted for the former reference to a \$5 fee, to give effect to the change made to former Art. 56, § 453(b) by Ch. 28, Acts of 1988. Section 2 of Ch. 28 specifically directed the publishers of the Annotated Code to incorporate similar changes in fees for real estate brokers into the relevant provisions of Art. 56A but did not contain a comparable directive for plumbers. Nonetheless, it seemed to be the intent of the General Assembly that the changes in fees for apprentice plumber be effective beyond October 1, 1988, when the relevant provisions amended by Ch. 28 -- i.e., former Art. 56, § 453(b) -- were repealed by Ch. 647, Acts of 1988, and replaced by, inter alia, Art. 56A, § 3-303. Accordingly, the change is incorporated into this section. As to the period from October 1, 1988, through the effective date of this section, October 1, 1989, see Ch. ____, Acts of 1989.
