2. \$30 FOR A JOURNEY PLUMBER LICENSE OR A LIMITED JOURNEY PLUMBER LICENSE.

(B) ISSUANCE.

ON PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE FEE AND, IF APPLICABLE, RECEIPT OF THE PROOF OF THE INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER § 12-501 OF THIS TITLE, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(a)(2)(ii) of this section, subsection the references to fees of \$75 and \$30 are substituted for the former references to \$30 and \$15, respectively, to give effect to changes made to former Art. 56, §§ 450 and 453(b) by Ch. 28, Acts of 1988.
