

WHILE A JOURNEY PLUMBER LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PROVIDE PLUMBING SERVICES ONLY UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF A MASTER PLUMBER OR A HOLDER OF A LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE.

(C) APPRENTICE PLUMBER.

WHILE AN APPRENTICE PLUMBER LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING PLUMBING SERVICES ONLY UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF A MASTER PLUMBER OR A HOLDER OF A LIMITED MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE.

12-308. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSES.

UNLESS A LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST MAY 1 THAT COMES:

- (1) AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LICENSE; AND
- (2) IN AN ODD-NUMBERED YEAR.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE, AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:

- (1) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND
- (2) A NOTICE THAT STATES:

(I) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

(II) THE DATE BY WHICH THE BOARD MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

(III) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.
