A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, MARYLAND INTRODUCED AND PASSED PURSUANT TO ITS GENERAL POWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING AND REVISING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, AND IN PARTICULAR AMENDING ARTICLE V. SECTION 515 OF THE PRESENT CITY CHARTER AS ADOPTED AND EFFECTIVE ON APRIL 6, 1983, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS PERTAINING TO VACANCY OF A CANDIDATE PRIOR TO A GENERAL ELECTION.
