A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, MARYLAND, INTRODUCED AND PASSED PURSUANT TO ITS GENERAL POWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING AND REVISING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, AND IN PARTICULAR AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 208 OF THE PRESENT CITY CHARTER AS ADOPTED AND EFFECTIVE ON APRIL 6, 1983, AND AS AMENDED AND EFFECTIVE ON NOVEMBER 16, 1983, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS PERTAINING TO THE PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES.
