AN ORDINANCE WHICH AMENDS THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF HANCOCK ADOPTING A PROHIBITION BARRING TOWN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FROM CONTINUED EMPLOYMENT AFTER FILING A CERTIFICATE OF NOMINATION FOR ELECTION TO ELECTIVE TOWN PUBLIC OFFICE AND FURTHER AMENDING THE CHARTER TO BAR THE EMPLOYMENT BY THE TOWN OF ELECTIVE TOWN OFFICE HOLDERS EXCEPT UNDER EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Hancock have determined that it is in the public interest to avoid conflicts of interest in the administration of the Town's governmental affairs.

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND AND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION AND AMENDMENTS THERETO) TITLED "CORPORATIONS--MUNICIPAL"; TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 3H ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE.
