for the changing of the charter to allow signatures of all City officers on its bonds to be of facsimile as long as there is a manual signature on each bond of the Trustee or Bond Registrar and to remove the requirement that the City Treasurer be in all cases responsible for the safekeeping of the unsold bonds.

A RESOLUTION of the Council of the City of Salisbury proposing the annexation to the City of Salisbury of a certain area of land situated contiguous to and binding upon the easterly Corporate Limits of the City of Salisbury, popularly known as the "Clark Farm Annexation" said area of land bounded on the north in part by Belmont Avenue and in part by the lands of R. Farrell and the lands known as Givan's Addition; bounded on the east by Fairfield Subdivision; bounded on the south side by the Corporate Limits at the southerly side of U.S. Route 50; bounded on the west by the lands of Ross Waterman.
