13-201. GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY.

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LICENSING OF PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCIES AND THE REGULATION OF THOSE PERSONS WHO PROVIDE PRIVATE DETECTIVE SERVICES IN THE STATE.

13-202. POWERS AND DUTIES.

(A) POWERS.

IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY:

- (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE;
- (2) USE ANY MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE, AS NECESSARY, TO CARRY OUT AND ENFORCE THIS TITLE; AND
- (3) MAKE INQUIRIES AND CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION REGARDING ANY APPLICANT:
 - (I) FOR A LICENSE; OR
 - (II) FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH A LICENSEE AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE OR SECURITY GUARD.

(B) DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO ANY DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:

- (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF EMPLOYEES OF PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCIES AS:
 - (I) PRIVATE DETECTIVES; AND
 - (II) SECURITY GUARDS; AND
