

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

- (1) Protect underground facilities of public service companies from destruction, damage or dislocation;
- (2) Require notice before excavation;
- (3) Establish certain excavating procedures;
- (4) Require certain duties of excavators; and
- (5) Generally regulate the excavation of underground utility facilities.

Chapter 22

Laws of Montgomery County, 1989

AN ACT to:

- (1) require a timely adequate public facility determination [[by the Planning Board]] under certain circumstances as a prerequisite to building permit issuance for certain developments;
- (2) require registration by certain owners of property upon certain notice;
- (3) establish a registry;
- (4) impose a certain registration fee;
- [[2]] (5) establish certain rights to a hearing, hearing procedures and criteria;
- [[3]] (6) provide certain exceptions;
- [[4]] (7) authorize the execution of certain agreements and imposition of certain conditions;
- (8) provide certain penalties for submission of false information;
- [[5]] provide for the assignment of certain planning functions to the Planning Board;
