Laws of Montgomery County, 1989

AN ACT to:

- (1) extend the controls on resales of moderately priced dwelling units;
- (2) revise the requirements for building moderately priced dwelling units in certain circumstances;
- (3) allow increases in prices for certain moderately priced dwelling units to improve certain design features;
- (4) clarify the requirements for building moderately priced dwelling units in certain zones and after a special exception is granted;
- (5) allow housing developers to meet the requirements of buildings moderately priced dwelling units through certain alternatives;
- (6) allow the Director of Housing and Community Development to impose certain restrictions on the builders of moderately priced dwelling units;
