THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SUBTITLE 3. PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY LICENSES.

13-301. LICENSE REQUIRED; ELIGIBILITY.

(A) LICENSE REQUIRED.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY BEFORE THE PERSON MAY CONDUCT A BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES PRIVATE DETECTIVE SERVICES IN THE STATE.
