COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

AN AMENDMENT to the Montgomery County Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of

- Minimizing Adverse Impacts of Nonresidential Uses in Residential Areas by (1) Restricting the Scale of Charitable (Eleemosynary) or Philanthropic Institutions in Most One-Family, Detached Residential Zones unless previously Approved for Expansion, and (2) Eliminating Charitable or Philanthropic Institutions from Other Residential Zones.
