13-302. QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER OF FIRMS.

IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM, THE FIRM SHALL APPOINT A FIRM MEMBER AS THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER TO MAKE THE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE FIRM.

(C) CHARACTER.

(1) IF THE APPLICANT IS AN INDIVIDUAL, THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD CHARACTER AND REPUTATION.

(2) IF THE APPLICANT IS A FIRM, EACH FIRM MEMBER SHALL BE OF GOOD CHARACTER AND REPUTATION.

(D) AGE.

THE INDIVIDUAL APPLICANT OR THE REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER SHALL BE AT LEAST 25 YEARS OLD.

(E) EXPERIENCE.

THE APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS OF § 13-303 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
