13-408. PRIVATE DETECTIVE BADGES.

A CERTIFIED PRIVATE DETECTIVE MAY WEAR OR CARRY A BADGE ONLY IF:

(1) THE SUPERINTENDENT AUTHORIZES THE WEARING OR CARRYING OF THE BADGE;

(2) THE DESIGN OF THE BADGE IS APPROVED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT; AND

(3) THE BADGE IS ISSUED BY THE LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY THROUGH WHICH THE PRIVATE DETECTIVE IS CERTIFIED.

(1) FOR ANY APPLICABLE GROUND UNDER § 13-313 OF THIS TITLE;

(2) IF THE APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN CERTIFICATION AS A
