

- STATE;
- (1) IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING IN ANOTHER
 - (2) IS NOT A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE;
 - (3) DOES NOT HAVE A PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THIS STATE;
 - (4) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES; AND
 - (5) PAYS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$25.

(B) PURPOSE AND SCOPE.

THE PURPOSE OF A TEMPORARY LICENSE IS TO ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL APPLIES FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING AND THE BOARD CONSIDERS THAT APPLICATION.

(C) TERM.

(1) UNLESS THE HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY LICENSE APPLIES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 15-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE, FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE, IT EXPIRES 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE.

(2) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY LICENSE APPLIES FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING, THE TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE DATE THAT THE BOARD ACTS ON THE APPLICATION.

(3) IN NO EVENT IS A TEMPORARY LICENSE EFFECTIVE FOR MORE THAN 1 YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ITS ISSUANCE.

(D) AUTOMATIC TERMINATION.

IF A TEMPORARY LICENSE HOLDER'S LICENSE FROM THE OTHER STATE EXPIRES OR IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED, THE TEMPORARY LICENSE TERMINATES AUTOMATICALLY AND IMMEDIATELY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (c), and (d) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 339(b) and the first sentence and, as it related to the required form for application and application fee, the second sentence of (a) and, as it related to payment of fees to the Board, the first sentence of § 334(a).

Subsection (b) of this section is new language added to state expressly that which only was implied in the former law -- i.e., the purpose of a temporary license is to allow a professional land surveyor from another
