

EXAMINATION FOR A PARTICULAR LICENSE GIVEN ON A PARTICULAR DATE SHALL CONTAIN THE SAME QUESTIONS. HOWEVER, THE QUESTIONS MAY BE IN DIFFERENT ORDER.

(F) USE OF TESTING SERVICE.

(1) THE COMMISSION MAY USE A TESTING SERVICE TO ADMINISTER THE EXAMINATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION.

(2) IF THE COMMISSION USES A TESTING SERVICE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE TESTING SERVICE, SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE COMMISSION, MAY:

- (I) SET THE TIMES AND PLACES OF EXAMINATIONS;
- (II) GIVE APPLICANTS NOTICE OF THE EXAMINATIONS.

16-307. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE:

(1) SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSION PROVIDES;

(2) IF A TESTING SERVICE WAS USED TO ADMINISTER THE EXAMINATION, SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION A COPY OF THE EXAMINATION RESULTS OF THE APPLICANT;

(3) SHALL PAY INTO THE GUARANTY FUND ANY FEE REQUIRED UNDER § 16-403 OF THIS TITLE;

(4) SHALL PAY TO THE COMMISSION AN APPLICATION FEE OF:

- (I) \$80 FOR A REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSE;
- (II) \$50 FOR AN ASSOCIATE REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSE; OR
- (III) \$30 FOR A REAL ESTATE SALESPERSON LICENSE;
