3-203. CHAIRMAN.

FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AND WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN.

  - (A) QUORUM.

THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ARE A QUORUM.

(B) MEETINGS AND HEARINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS AND HEARINGS.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
  - (D) STAFF.
- (1) THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
- (2) THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE THE STAFF TO BE COVERED BY A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY LAW.
