(f) (3) Before a license expires, the licensee may renew it for an additional 1-year term, if the [licensee;] LICENSEE:

(i) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(ii) [Pay] PAYS to the clerk of the circuit court a renewal fee of \$25; and

(iii) Submits to the clerk of the circuit court a renewal application on the form the Comptroller requires.
