(n) The county or incorporated municipality may issue bonds or other certificates of indebtedness to carry out the provisions of this subtitle in accordance with provisions contained in the county or municipal charter or in a public general or public local law and may provide for the levying of ad valorem taxes upon the assessed value of all real property and upon such classes of assessable personal property as it may determine within the conversion district for the purpose of paying the principal and interest on any bonds or other certificates of indebtedness or advance from the general fund.
