- (ii) Must rent at least two-thirds of the dwelling units in the building to families of limited income;
- (iii) Must provide congregate or group housing or temporary shelters to families of limited income; or
- (iv) In the case of lead paint abatement loans, must provide services for children, such as a licensed child day care facility, in the portion of the building to be assisted by the loan.
- (f) (l) The Radon Gas and Asbestos Abatement Pilot Program shall be funded in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 [dollars] per year, with moneys appropriated for the Lead Paint Abatement Program as provided in § 2-313 of this subtitle.
