The Commission, subject to approval of the Secretary, may procure, sell, convey, assign, lease, or otherwise purchase, transfer, or dispose of any property acquired or held by it and enter into any contracts incident thereto, including but not limited to the authority to lease properties for residential or commercial use, for such term and such conditions as the Commission deems appropriate; except that leases made by the Commission shall be in immediate furtherance of the purposes of the Commission and not merely for investment purposes; and except that valuable lands and buildings transferred to the Commission by the State or purchased by the Commission with funds provided by the State shall not be conveyed or disposed of without the approval of the Board of Public Works. For the purposes of this section the term [valuable] "VALUABLE" shall mean any property or thing in excess of \$5,000.00 in value.
