SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-424.

While engaged in hunting or pursuing any wildlife, a person may not:

- (1) Carelessly or negligently shoot, wound, or kill another person; or
- (2) Intentionally or willfully destroy or damage any real property, personal property, or farm livestock of another person.

10-424.1.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAY SUSPEND THE HUNTING LICENSE OF A PERSON WHO IS CHARGED WITH A VIOLATION OF \S 10–424(1) OF THIS TITLE PENDING THE DISPOSITION OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEEDING AGAINST THE PERSON.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.
