(K) Minor League Baseball Stadia. Provide a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to plan, design, construct and equip a baseball stadium, subject to the requirement that the county provide a matching fund of \$5,000,000 and the team provide a matching fund of \$1,500,000 and further provide a grant to the City of Hagerstown for the repair, renovation, rehabilitation, reconstruction, construction, expansion, and equipping of Municipal Stadium, located in Hagerstown..... 2,525,000

(4) An annual tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of issue of the bonds.

(5) Prior to the payment of any matching grant funds under the provisions of Section 1(3), Item 50.01.00 above, grantees shall provide matching funds as specified. No part of a grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in-kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. Grantees have until June 1, 1995 to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1995, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in Section 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
